Surety & Fidelity Intern and Scholarship Program

- The Surety and Fidelity Intern & Scholarship Program was created to encourage diverse college students to consider the surety and fidelity industry as a career of choice.
- The program gives underrepresented* college students the opportunity to work with industry experts through paid, professional internships with our member organizations.
- Underrepresented students are defined as African American, Native American, Alaskan, Asian/Pacific Islander, Hispanic, female, LGBTQ+, veteran or disabled.

- Upon completion of an internship, students are eligible to apply for a \$5,000 academic scholarship.
- Seventeen \$5,000 academic scholarships awarded in 2021 for a total of \$85,000!
- The program was created in 2003 to help increase diversity within the surety and fidelity industry by attracting underrepresented students into the field.
